RESTAURANT WHERE ALCOHOL IS SERVED

It is not recommended to go at such places for 2 reasons:

1. It is a blameworthiness and non secure place.
2. Fear of cross contamination.

The Holy Prophet 'peace be upon him' said, avoid going to non secure place (blamed place).

When you will go there, may be people will blame you that you have involved in Haraam activities etc... Our Islamic Scholars said, if there are two roads to the Masjid, one is blamed [there is bar etc...] and the second is secured, so choice the best one.

Secondly, the Holy Prophet 'peace and blessing be on him' said:

عن أبي عبد الله النعمان بن بشير رضي الله عنهما قال: سمعت رسول الله صلى الله عليه وسلم يقول: (إن الحلال بين وإن الحرام بين وبينهما أمور مشتبهات لا يعلمهن كثير من الناس فمن اتقى الشبهات فقد استبرأ لدينه وعرضه ومن وقع في الشبهات وقع في الحرام كالراعي يرعى حول الحمى يوشك أن يرتع فيه ألا وإن لكل ملك حمى ألا وإن حمى الله محارمه ألا وإن في الجسد مضغة إذا صلحت صلح الجسد كله وإذا فسدت فسد الجسد كله ألا وهي القلب

Which is lawful is clear and that which is unlawful is clear and between the two of them is doubtful matters about which not many people know. Thus he who avoids doubtful matters clears himself in regard to his religion and his honor, but he who falls into doubtful matters falls into that which is unlawful. [Bukhari]
