Do's and don't

Allah Almighty says in the Holy Quran:

وَتَعَاوَنُوا عَلَى الْبِرِّ وَالتَّقْوَىٰ وَلَا تَعَاوَنُوا عَلَى الْاِثْمِ وَالْعُدْوَانِ وَاتَّقُوا اللَّهَ إِنَّ اللَّهَ شَدِيدُ الْعِقَابِ

Help one another in righteousness and piety but help not one another in sin and rancor, fear Allah, for Allah is strict in punishment. [Al Mayidah V2]

There are two kinds of deeds in accordance to obtain reward or punishment.

- (1) Deeds according to Shariah Law, actions to achieve the pleasure of Allah Almighty, the Holy Quran has named this kind of deed by Al-Birr (righteousness) and At-Taqwa (piety).
- (2) Deeds not according to Shariah Law, actions to achieve the dissatisfaction of Allah Almighty, the Holy Quran has named this kind of deed by Al-Ithm (sin) and Al-Udwaan (rancor).

If we want victory here and hereafter, so must take the first kind of deeds, and must help others in righteousness and piety, and must leave the second kind of deeds.

May Allah grant us the opportunity to help others in good deeds and protect us from all kind of evils.

At the same time, we congratulate the Sunni Rizvi Society for the Religious Activities, May Allah give the Society more courage and bravery to continue till the end. Ameen
